Associate Membership (\$30/year)

Persons interested in supporting and advancing the goals and purposes of the Association but who are not eligible or do not seek general membership. No voting rights.

Student Membership (\$20/year)

Persons enrolled full-time in an environmentally-related curriculum at an accredited college or university. No voting rights.

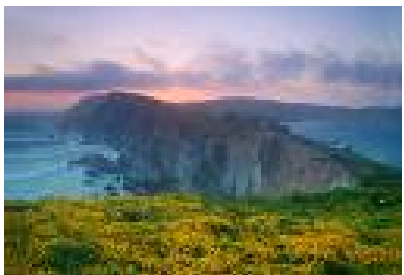
